#### Pastoral Lead

Mrs Hill has just started a course to become the school's ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant). She will be trained by some local Educational Psychologists in areas such as building resilience, friendships, self-esteem, motivation, feeling safe, separation, loss and bereavement.

I am sure you will agree this is a very worthwhile use of Mrs Hill's time and I'm sure many children will benefit from her training.


Details about ticket arrangements etc. will be sent out nearer the time.
